LATEST NEWS: This past week, we hosted the kickoff construction meeting for our Restoration project. Members of the Restoration committee, Diocese Building Facilities team, our General Contractor – Corna Kokosing and our architect, Scott Harper met to begin moving the project forward. The “Good News” is that we are on track to begin on May 1st. This is when we begin to start removing pews, platform and part of the flooring. The large stain glass windows get removed in the first two weeks of the project. We have to do some protection of the organ and our sound system.

The Restoration Committee will continue to provide updates in the Bulletin and at weekend Masses.

THE LAST MASSES held in the church before restoration begins will be on the weekend of April 29th and 30th. Father Ted will have a special ceremony at each Mass.

Live the Gospel:

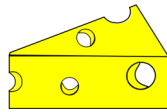

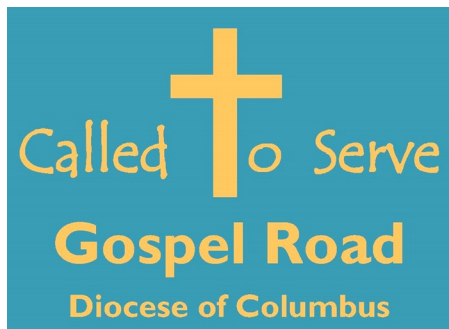


Flower Sale
