Fraser Cameron opened the meeting with prayer.

Minutes: Mike Logan made a motion to accept the November meeting minutes and Ann Short seconded the motion. The minutes of the November 18, 2012 meeting were approved as written. Note: There was no meeting in December.

Reports:

PSR/Youth Ministry: Fifteen youth are receiving the Sacrament of Reconciliation for the first time on Sunday, January 27. Sixteen Junior High youth will be participating in the Bosco Bash on February 2. This is a Jr. High Youth Rally presented by the Diocese. The annual ski/tubing trip will be held on February 10th. There are approximately 20 people signed up and this is open to the families. Several youth will be participating in a World Vision 30 Hour Famine program. The youth fast for 30 hours and raise funds for World Vision and awareness of hunger. There will be a collection after the Masses on February 24th. The high school youth rally will be held in March. The Amazing Race event will be May 5th. Graduation Mass to honor the seniors will be May 18th at the 5 p.m. Mass. A Cedar Point trip is planned for June 26-28th. In July there are two mission trips. The first trip is to Betsy Lane, KY, with Catholic Work Camp and 22 people (17 youth and 5 adults) have signed up for this mission trip. The second trip is to New Philadelphia, OH with Gospel Road (the mission that the Diocese organizes). Currently have 18 youth signed up for this one. The National Catholic Youth Conference will be held in Indianapolis, IN in November. There are 6 youth interested in going. There will be fundraising activities soon. It costs \$550 to attend this 3 day conference.

Deanery: No report.

Finance: Fr Ted reported that there was no meeting. We are not in the red.

Stewardship: Pat Keaton presented the Diocesan Family Registration Form that will be used for registration. The plan is to have the current form available for the entire month of April so that families can update them. There will be individuals helping parish members with the update. Intent is to get current number for the BAA and use the form for Time, Talent and Treasure. Want to get current phone numbers and email address. There are a lot of logistics that still have to be worked out.

Parish Activities: Advent went well. There will be a pancake dinner for Shrove Tuesday. The church will furnish the pancakes and parish members are asked to bring something to share. There will be a St. Joseph/St. Patrick potluck either the 16th or 17th of March. The Columbus Catholic Women's Conference will be held on February 23rd.

Old Business:

1. Red Cross Blood Drive ó Frank Latella reported that we surpassed the goal for blood donation. Erica Theller will be the liaison for the Blood drives in the future. The next one is scheduled for March 15th from 2 p.m. to 8 p.m. The next one after that will be June 21st.
2. Restoration Steering Committee ó Father is working on the committee. Wants a design for inside and determine structural soundness.
3. Discontinuation of Parish Council Assembly ó to be determined after the February meeting.
4. New member registration will still be held monthly in the sacristy. Those registering the individuals will be sure to ask if they are already Catholic and from which parish are you transferring.
